Maintain open lines of communication with healthcare providers to ensure the child's medical needs are met.

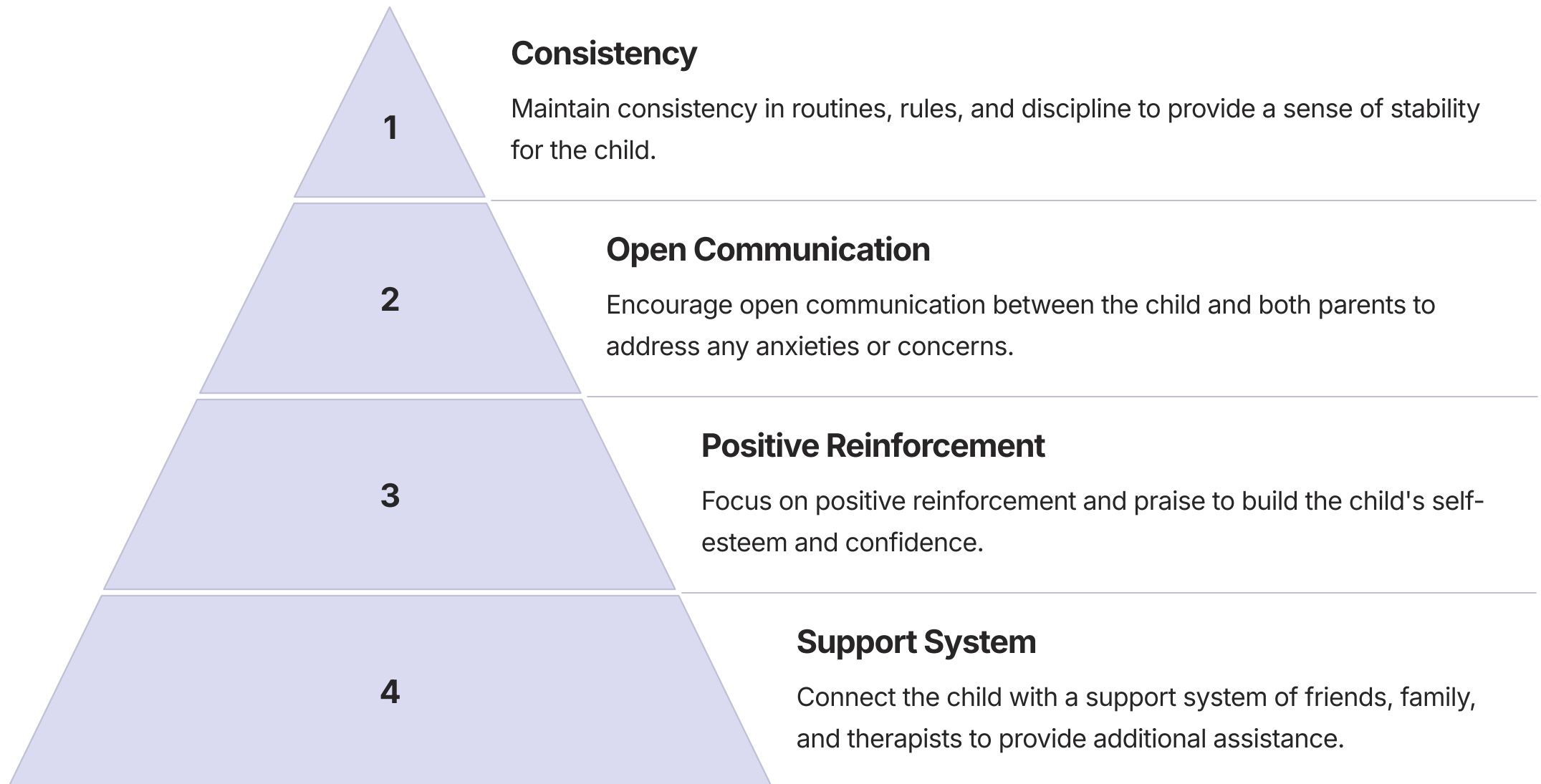
