## Initial Meeting

4

## Agreement

# Financial Disclosures and Division of Assets

## Full Disclosure

Both parties must disclose financial assets and debts.

## Equitable Distribution

Assets are divided fairly, not necessarily equally.

## Best Interests

Decisions must prioritize the child's well-being.



## Parenting Schedule

A structured plan for time with each parent.



## Child Support

Financial support for the child's needs.



# Finalizing the Mediation Agreement

## Review and Sign

Both parties review and sign the agreement.

## Court Approval

The agreement must be submitted to the court for approval.

3

## Final Judgment

The court issues a final judgment incorporating the agreement.
